The library supplies each member with 4 videos per month for \$10 plus the cost of posting them on to the next person. Usually about \$7.50. Often two families share.

EDITORIAL


In an article published in the London Weekly Telegraph, for the week ending Sunday 14th January 1996 which is the weekly overseas edition of the London Daily Telegraph, it reported that the Church of England in England has recently released a report prepared by its Doctrinal Commission stating, that Hell is a state of annihilation rather than eternal torment.

The Commission, chaired by the Bishop of Newcastle, the Rt. Rev. Alec Graham, does not believe that everybody of all faiths will be automatically saved.

'No one can be automatically installed in Heaven,' the report goes on, 'The possibility remains for a final rejection of God. Final judgement therefore remains a reality. Salvation is only through God.'

Is not eternal torment, but the final and irrevocable choosing of that which is opposed to God, so completely and absolutely that the only end is total non-being.'

Heaven is not 'eternal and static perfection', but an everlasting 'participation in the life of God.'



It is good to see such confirmation of basic Christian belief.

Their understanding of Hell is quite different from the Calvinistic concept of the eternal torment of immortal souls, which is so firmly held by so many denominations. It will be interesting to see if it sparks any public debate as time goes on.

This month I commend to you Pastor Allen's letter about the phenomenon of aging, also the statement on *The Church* by Hans Kung that will challenge all of us.

Dear Friend

Last week I met a friend. I see him regularly because he sits in one of my congregations. On this particular day he was struggling to stay awake during my sermon. Afterwards he discussed this behaviour with me and noted that as the years had accumulated, he found himself feeling more and more weary. 'I guess when death comes', he said, 'it will be quite welcome because I will have become so tired.' My friend's remark has spurred me to write on the subject of old age. Are you now what is known as a venerable old gentleman or gracious old lady? If you are a senior citizen then what I have to say is particularly for you, although I should like you to read on even if you are still in your prime.

There is more than a benediction for the aged. There is a gospel as well. Here are some positive things about growing old.

- 1. Think of growing old as a perfectly normal phase which fits into God's plan just as much as does youth. Jesus said to Peter, 'follow me' Later he spoke again saying, 'I tell you the truth, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go.' John 21:18. Jesus transfigured Peter's life when he was in his youth. Christ was his mainstay in the middle years and his solace in death. Following Jesus was the unifying factor throughout all of Peter's life. The eventide of life was not outside the scope of God any more than life's morning. It is possible that a person can offer even more to the world after 50 than before because, his/her spirit has been enriched by Christ over many years.
- 2. Do not cling to youth. If youth is departing, let it go. Accept the fact. Elderly people have a ripeness with which they can minister to the world. There is nothing more pathetic than an old man who is still trying to behave like one of the boys; flirting with the girls etc. Or for that matter, an aged lady who desperately tries to conceal her years with cosmetic tricks. Aged people have a mellowness and a wisdom which they can share. They have learned patience and faith. Senior citizens can give to the world things which youth cannot.
- 3. If you are planning to retire do not do so until you are sure just what you are going to do instead of going to work. Very few people know how to retire successfully. Those who do are those who continue to allow their minds to be engaged by activities satisfying to their personalities.
- 4. Realise that Christ has made old age into you. In the Old Testament people dreaded old age because it brought death near and death, if it wasn't the end, was a shadowy and melancholy experience.

Men were always pleading with God for length of days. Long life was thought of as the great reward. 'With long life will I satisfy Thee and show Thee my salvation.' Psalm 91:16. The certain thing was in the Old Testament that, 'as for man his days are as grass.' Psalm 103:15. There is a much different perspective in the New Testament. Christ was certain of the life beyond the grave and of reunion with loved ones in it. Paul could not make up his mind whether he would rather die or live. 'I am in a straight betwixt the two, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better.' Phillipians 1:23. When Paul came to his last days he could write to Timothy 'I am ready to be offered up ... I have fought the good fight I have finished the course I have kept the faith, henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness.' 2 Timothy 4:6-8. The New Testament vibrates with this resurrection certainty. This is why I say that the gospel turns old age into youth. Christ can turn the waning years into a beautiful evening with a glorious sunset.

So be my passing!
My task accomplished and the long day done,
My wages taken, and in my heart
Some late lark singing,
Let me be gathered to the quiet west,
The sundown splendid and serene ...

There was a epitaph upon an English grave which went like this. 'When we saw the glory of His sun setting, we said, it will be a lovely tomorrow.'

To what kind of Christian, to what kind of church, does the future belong?

Not to a church that is lazy, shallow, indifferent, timid and weak in its faith;

Not to a church that expects blind obedience and fanatical party loyalty;

Not to a church that is the slave of its own history, always putting on the brakes, suspiciously defensive and yet in the end, forced into agreement;

Not to a church that is anti-critical, practically anti-intellectual and dilettantish;

Not to a church that is blind to problems, suspicious of empirical knowledge, yet claiming competent authority for everyone and everything;

Not to a church that is quarrelsome, impatient and unfair in dialoque;

Not to a church that is closed to the real world.

In short, the future does not belong to a church that is dishonest!

No, the future belongs:

To a church that knows what it does not know;

To a church that relies upon God's grace and wisdom and has in its weakness and ignorance; a radical confidence in God;

To a church that is strong in faith, joyous and certain, yet self-critical;

To a church filled with intellectual desire, spontaneity, animation and fruitfulness;

To a church that has the courage of initiative, and the courage to take risks:

To a church that is altogether open to the real world;

In short, the future belongs to a thoroughly truthful church.

Hans Küng was born in Switzerland in 1928. He is considered one of the world's leading theologians and ecumenists. He has had difficulties with his own Roman Catholic Church hierarchy. His books include, On Being a Christian, Does God Exist? and Infalliable? The above statement is form the United Presbyterian March A.D. 1981, page 25.


EUTHANASIA






